Please remind your children that each day they go to CHSRC they also go to a church campus. Everyone is expected to behave with respect for each other, as well as, all adults they encounter.

Campus Safety

Supervision of students: The safety of each child is of the utmost priority. Following the guidelines of SGBC, all students 12 and under need to be supervised at all times. Staff is responsible for supervising students 13 and up ONLY during event time. It is the parents responsibility to make sure their child follows safe and appropriate behavior prior to and after their CHSRC activity.

Drop-off and pick-up: Elementary students may be escorted into their class, by the parent, 5 minutes before start time. At the end of each class, elementary students can be picked up in the classroom. Parents of 12 and under **IOWA testing** students are expected to remain with their child until testing begins. Please pick up your child promptly. Late pick-up fees of \$25 per hour (charged in 15 minute increments) may apply.

First aid: There is a fully stocked first aid kit on site. The teacher or office staff will administer first aid for minor scrapes. Parents will be notified immediately if health issues or accidents occur.

Restroom Policy: Children <u>12 and under are required to be supervised by a parent or guardian while in the restroom. Please make sure your child uses the restroom prior to their scheduled event.</u>

General Information

Class Schedules: All class schedules are available at <u>chsrc.org</u>. Please mark your calendars with all registered event dates. CHSRC does not send reminder emails.

Class Placement: Students wishing to register for a class above their grade level must first obtain permission from the instructor. If permission is not secured in advance, CHSRC reserves the right to withdraw the student if the class content proves to be beyond their academic or maturity level. No refunds will be issued in this case.

Attendance & Absences: Due to the significant preparation involved in classes, testing, and events, please notify the CHSRC office as soon as possible if your student will be absent. All class and testing fees are non-refundable. Make-up work is not provided.

Student Conduct & Devices: To maintain a focused learning environment, cell phones and all related functions (including cameras and apps) are not permitted during classes or testing sessions.

Photography & Media: Photos and/or videos may be taken by CHSRC staff and used in promotional materials including our website, emails, and social media. If you have concerns, please contact the office.

Special Needs or Accommodations: Prior to registration, parents must notify CHSRC if their child has any needs that may impact classroom interaction or require accommodations. CHSRC reserves the right to withdraw a student if it becomes evident that the class is not a good fit for the child or for the group.

Unexcused Absences: Students with two consecutive unexcused absences may be administratively withdrawn from the class. Refunds will not be given. Make-up work may be provided upon request, at the discretion of the instructor.
